Export Manufacturing Industry Reaffirms Commitment to Incoming Government



On October 1, a new government led by Dr. Claudia Sheinbaum Pardo begins, marking a historic milestone as the first woman president of Mexico.

In light of this new beginning, the National Council of the Maquiladora and Export Manufacturing Industry (index) reaffirms its commitment to the incoming government. The sector holds high expectations for dialogue and cooperation in facing the challenges ahead for our country, contributing through investments, exports, the creation of formal and well-paid jobs, social responsibility, and programs benefiting companies and their employees.

In recent weeks, meetings with members of the incoming cabinet, including representatives from the Secretariats of Economy, Finance, Labor, IMSS, Agriculture, and Foreign Relations, among others, have instilled confidence in our sector. The sector contributes to 60% of exports and generates nearly 10 million direct and indirect jobs through IMMEX companies.

Currently, our country is involved in the business relocation and supply chain reshoring phenomenon, consolidating the presence and/or expansion of already established companies in Mexico, as well as those seeking to establish themselves in the North American region.

With the start of this new six-year term, the export manufacturing industry, the National Council index, its 18 associations across the country, and over 6,500 global companies that manufacture in Mexico are open to cooperating with the new government to generate well-being and growth for our country.
