## National Council INDEX congratulates Claudia Sheinbaum, virtual winner of the presidency of Mexico

The National Council of the Maquiladora and Export Manufacturing Industry (INDEX) extends hearty congratulations to Dr. Claudia Sheinbaum Pardo for her victory in the 2024 electoral process, achieving the historic designation as the first female president of Mexico.

In the industrial and business sector of our country, we reaffirm our commitment to the upcoming administration she will lead and reiterate the importance of the export manufacturing sector in the national economy, its contribution to GDP growth, and the creation of more than 9 million direct and indirect jobs.

Since the beginning of the year, INDEX Nacional, through its president, Humberto Martínez Cantú, and its general director, Carlos Palencia, held meetings with Altagracia Gómez, Juan Ramón de la Fuente, Omar García Harfuch, and Arturo Zaldívar, members of the then-candidate's team.
